<b>Learning Agreement</b>	The learning agreement must be sent to the academic advisor <b>one month before classes start.</b>
<b>Arrival in Mérida</b>	We strongly recommend students' arrival <b><u>one week before the orientation day.</u></b>

<b>Transcripts</b>	The <b>Transcript of Records</b> (Grade Report) will be sent to the International Office at the home University (not to the students) in February for the Fall Term and in July for the Spring Term.
<b>International Health Insurance</b>	We require that exchange students have an International Health Insurance that covers <b>expenses for illness, accident or hospitalization, and repatriation of remains.</b>
